

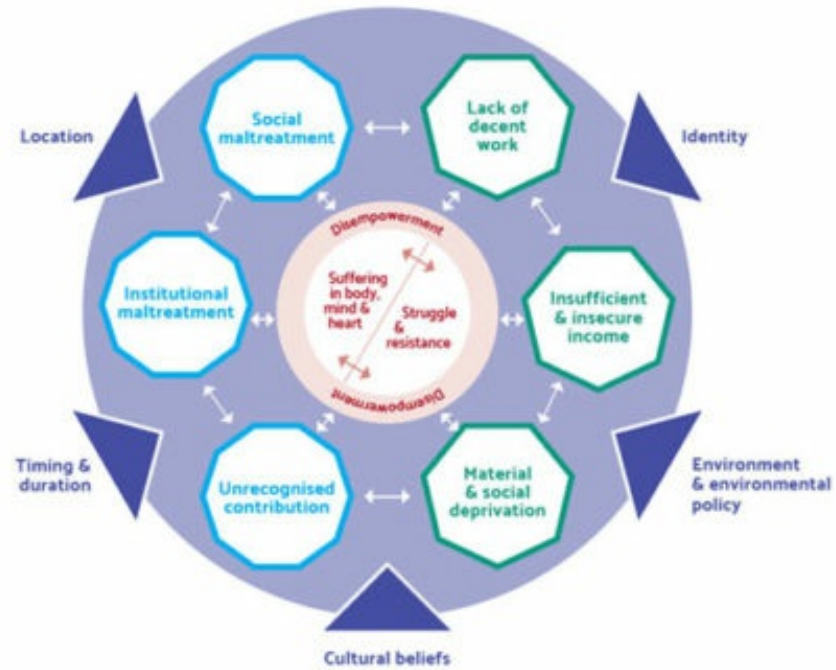
WHO DECIDES HOW WE DEFINE POVERTY?

The hidden dimensions of poverty

International participatory research

ATD Fourth World, in partnership with Oxford University, conducted a participatory international research project called "[The Hidden Dimensions of Poverty](#)". The project took place in six countries: Bangladesh, Bolivia, France, Tanzania, the United Kingdom and the United States.

For three years, people living in poverty, professionals and academics worked together to clarify how we understand poverty and its multi-dimensional aspects. Research teams defined nine interdependent dimensions common to all six countries. The long-term goal of this project is to help develop better policies to eradicate of poverty.
