

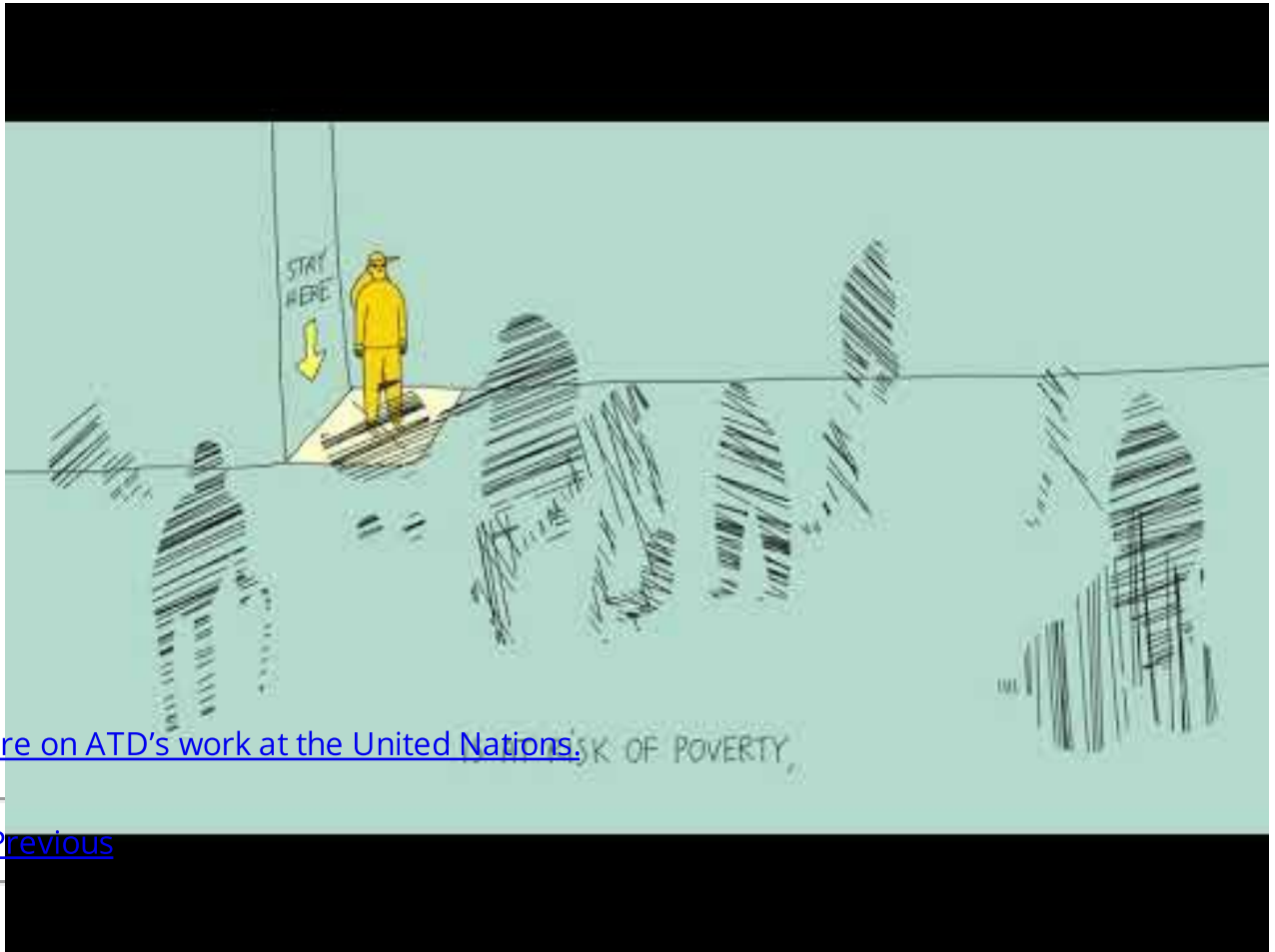
SPEAKING OF POVERTY DIFFERENTLY
