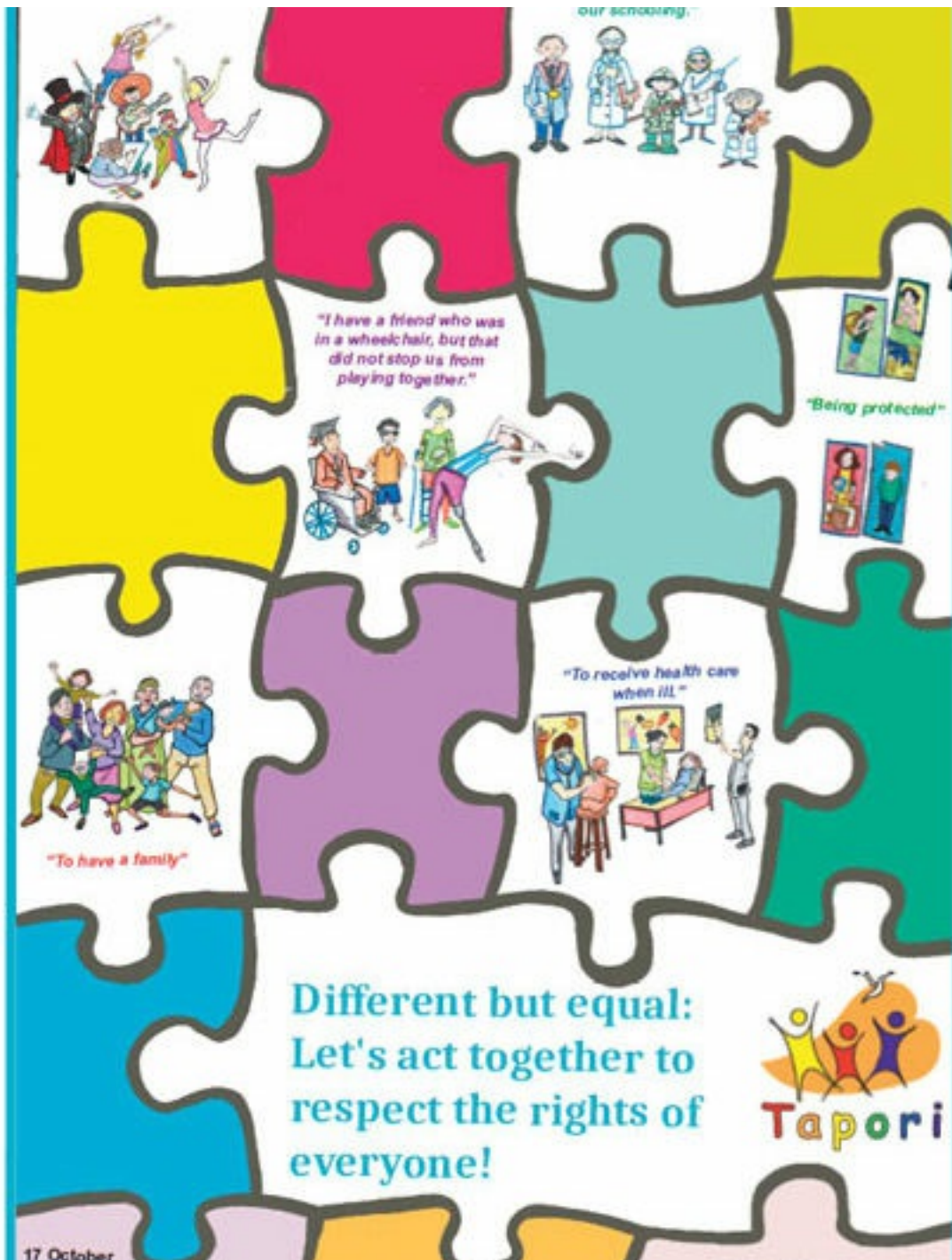


# TAPORI NEWSLETTER – OCTOBER-DECEMBER 2018
